The \$500 Film School will allow students the chance to learn the skills increasingly in demand in the world of new media.

Denver Open Media, the public access television station operated by Open Media Foundation, makes this possible through their Equipment and Training Access Membership. The membership also includes access to [high-end video equipment](#) and studios to produce content for the station.

“We believe everyone should have the access to the knowledge and tools necessary to create effective and compelling media,” says John Aden, Media Education Coordinator at the Open Media Foundation. “The \$500 Film School offer allows community members to learn these skills and have access to high-end equipment without going thousands of dollars into debt.”
