



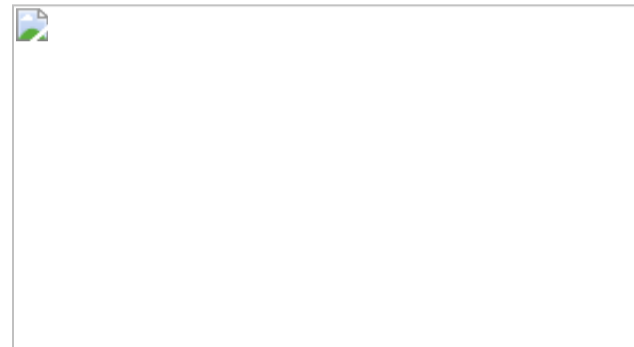

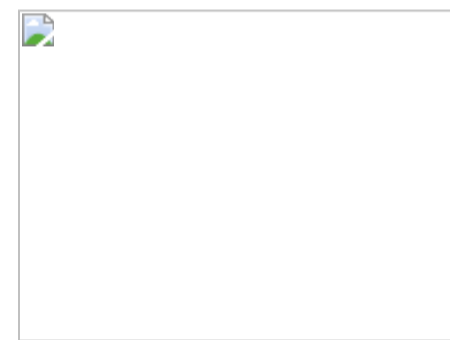
Celebrate Like-Wyse Production's first year anniversary this First Friday at Denver Open Media!

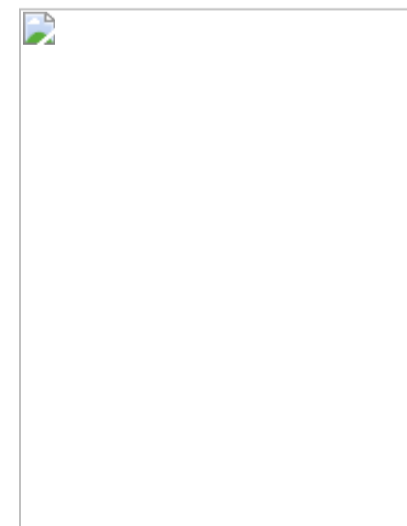

### New Radio Station Signals

You may have noticed some changes in the local FM dial. This month, OMF has transitioned Denver Open Media Radio from 104.7FM (a 100Watt Low-Power FM Station) to 92.9FM (a 250Watt FM Translator) and 89.3HD3 (a 22,500Watt HD substation of KUVQ). These new signals provide a much larger reach for Denver's only all-local radio station.



We will be testing the new signals throughout April and May, with a re-launch celebration planned for June 7th, the 3rd anniversary of the launch of DOM Radio! Get involved at [denveropenmedia.org](#).
