African-American Media in 1800's Colorado



Over one-third of the 42 African-American newspapers in Colorado listed by [Wikipedia](#) were published before the 20th century. The Denver Star was the first, published fourteen years after the civil war. Publishers in Colorado Springs and Pueblo started distributing newspapers a few years later. Now, in the 21st century, new digital media and social platforms have permeated society and drastically transformed the media landscape.

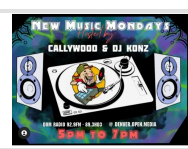

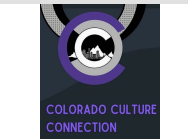

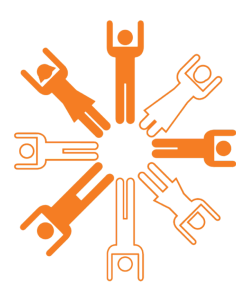

The Dalles, OR on Open Media

The Dalles is the largest city of [Wasco County, Oregon, United States](#). The site was a major Native American trading center. The name of the city comes from the French word *dalle*, meaning "sluice" referring to the [columnar basalt](#) rocks carved by the Columbia river. The Dalles was incorporated as a city in 1857 and now has a population of 16,010.

Showings start on February 3rd. The Holly goes deep inside a gentrifying community in Denver, where a shooting case involving activist Terrance Roberts becomes a window into the political machinations of urban development and the city's gang activity. The shooting happened at a peace rally in the "Holly," an area that was once the center of Denver's civil rights movement. Rubinstein, who grew up in Denver, began to report on the case and recognized that public reporting on what happened was not representative of what he was hearing in the neighborhood.
