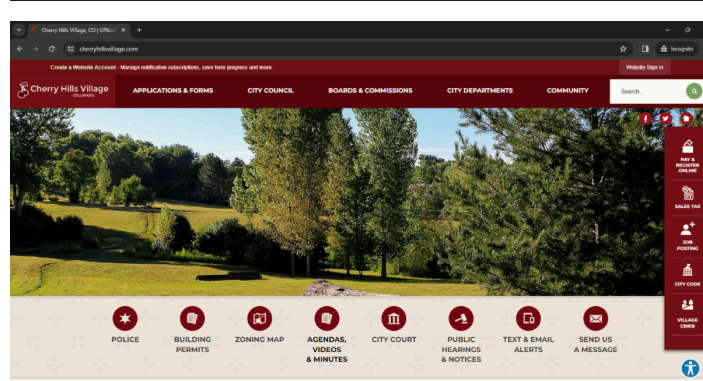

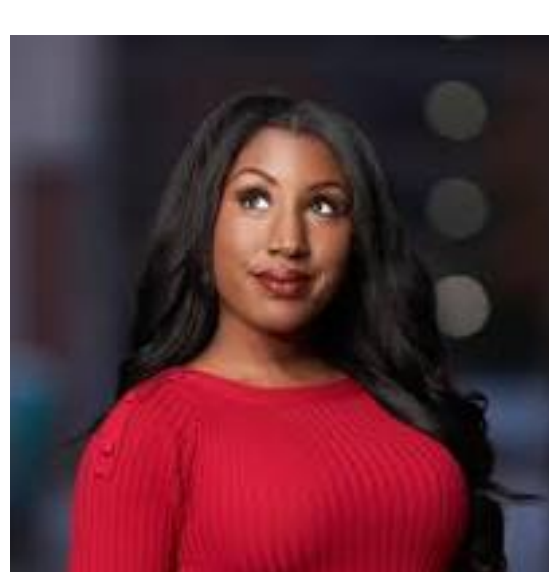
### February is Black History Month
