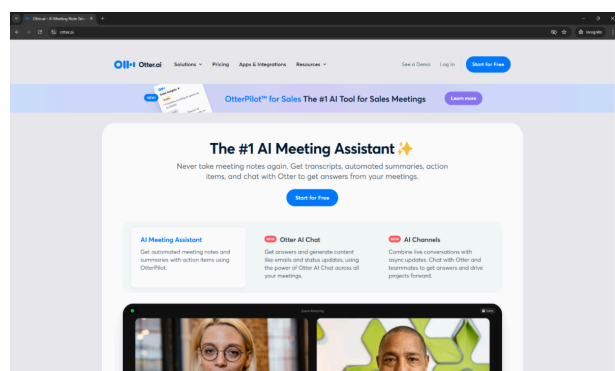

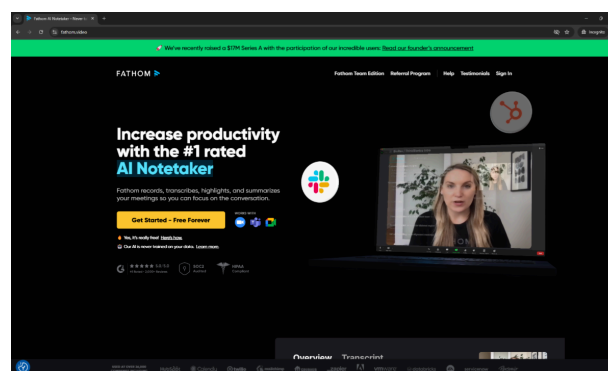
AI Meeting Assistants

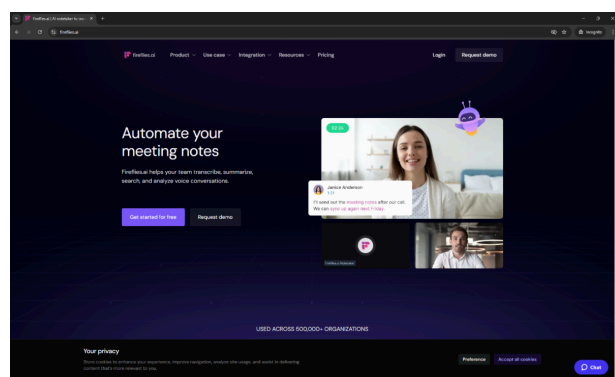

OtterPilot generates automated meeting notes and summaries with action items. It also generates content like emails and status updates.



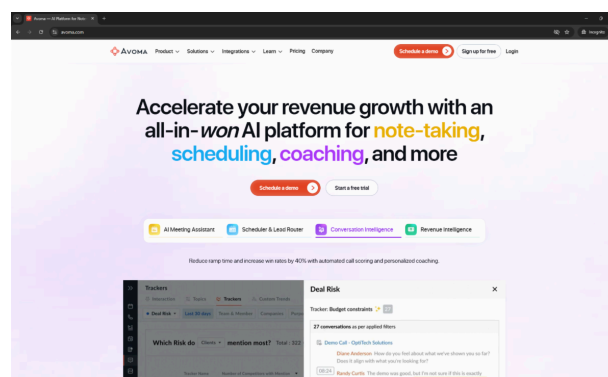

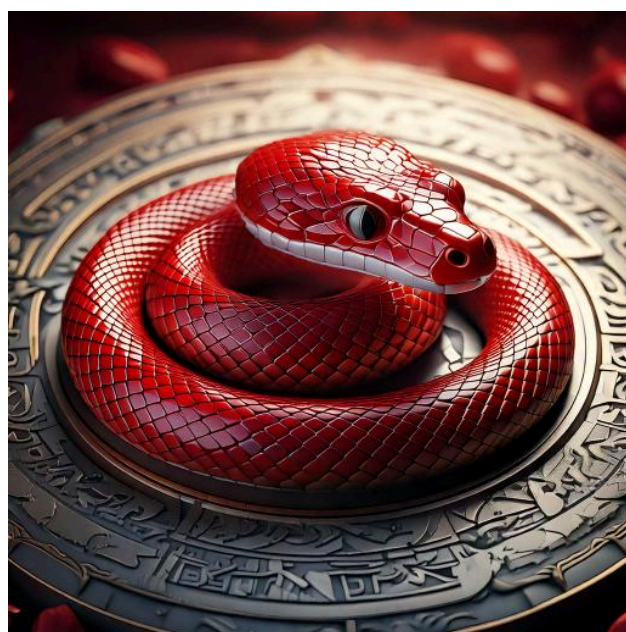


January 20th is Civil Rights Day in Observance of Martin Luther King Jr.

On November 2, 1983, President Ronald Reagan signed the King Holiday Bill into law, designating the third Monday in January a federal holiday in observance of civil rights leader Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. The legislation was first introduced 15 years earlier on April 4, 1968.

Still, it would take an additional 17 years for it to be recognized in all 50 states. Today, it is the only federal holiday designated as a national day of service to encourage all Americans to volunteer and improve their communities.

Chinese New Year is on January 29th

2025 is the year of the Snake based on Chinese zodiac. This is a year of Wood Snake, starting from Jan. 29, 2025 to Feb. 16, 2026. Snake is the sixth in the 12-year cycle of the Chinese zodiac sign.

Snake carries the meanings of malevolence, cattiness, mystery, as well as acumen and divination. In ancient Chinese traditions, the snake once presented a venerated image and it is one of the earliest totems of Chinese nations.
