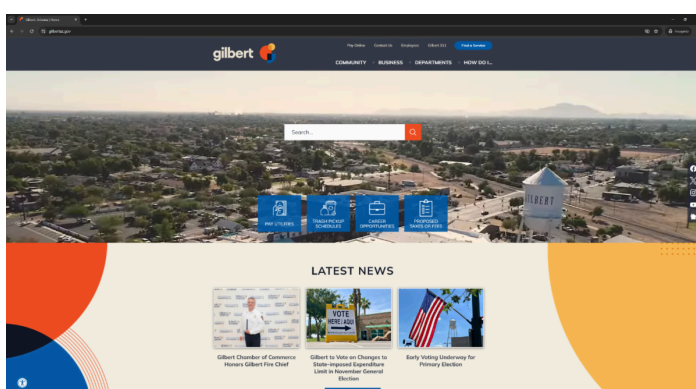

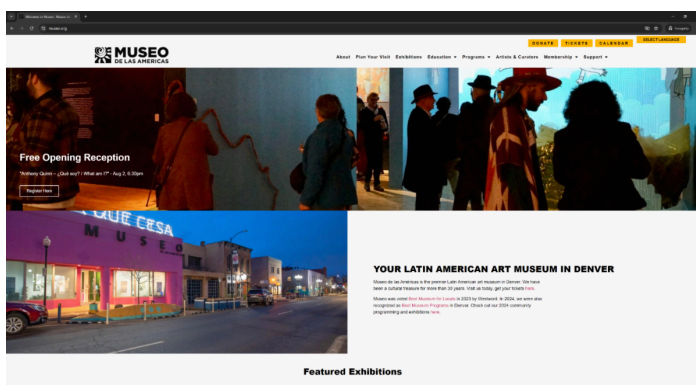
Gilbert AZ on Open.Media

Gilbert is a town in Maricopa County, Arizona, located southeast of Phoenix. Gilbert is home to 288,128 residents and is the fifth-largest municipality in Arizona.

Gilbert was established by William "Bobby" Gilbert, who provided land to the Arizona Eastern Railway in 1902 to construct a rail line between Phoenix and Florence, Arizona. Incorporated on July 6, 1920, Gilbert was primarily a farming community fueled by the rail line and construction of the Roosevelt Dam and the Eastern and Consolidated Canals. It remained an agricultural town for many years and was known as the "Hay Capital of the World" until the late 1920s.

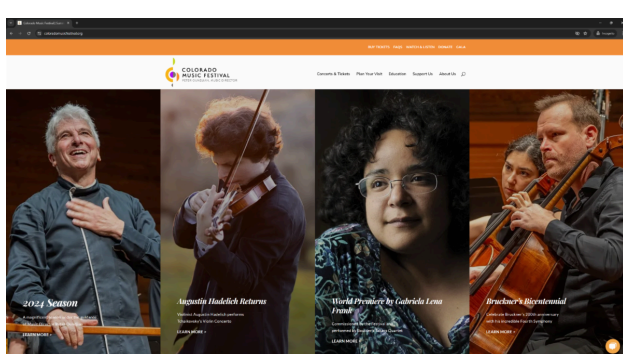
