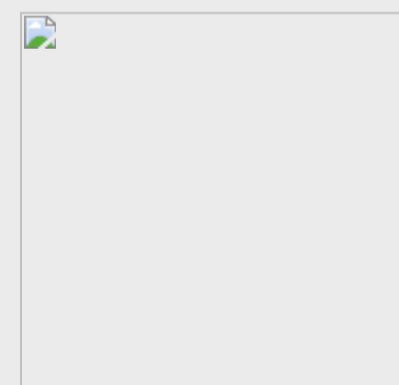

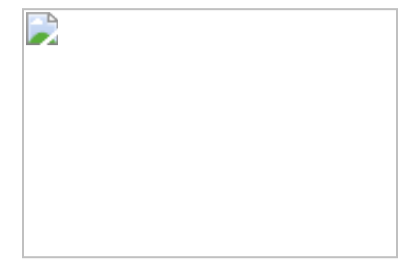

## Letter from the Executive Director



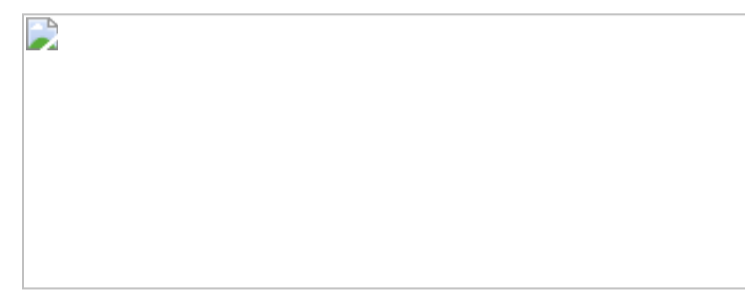

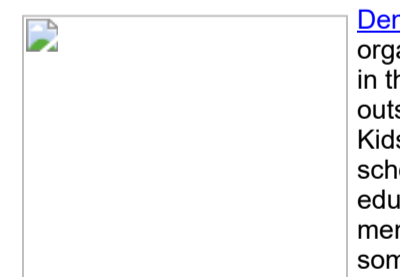

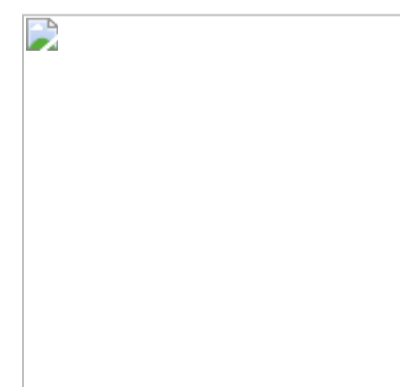
## Video Client Profile - Denver Kids

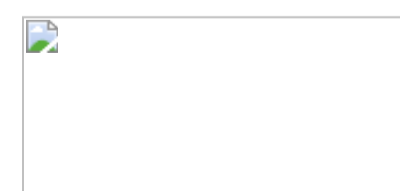

## OMF Wins Knight Prototype Fund Award



OMF is excited to announce that it is receiving project funding from the [Knight Foundation's Prototype Fund](#) for *She Said, He Said* (SSHS).

SSHS is an experiment in government transparency, making accessible the daily work of Colorado representatives, candid documentation of their stances, and effectiveness. SSHS leverages voice recognition/audio analysis libraries to create an audio thumbprint for each legislator. It allows users to look up every time a legislator discussed a particular topic or referred to any issue.

SSHS is an extension of OMF's work with the [Colorado Channel](#), where we stream and archive every session of the Colorado State House and Senate.

The Knight Prototype Fund helps to create prototypes as a way to make small bets on exploratory work that promises to create new pathways for information that is essential for communities. The fund provides \$35,000 and training in human-centered design. Click [here](#) to learn more.
