Help us celebrate the one-year anniversary of [Denver Open Media 104.7FM](#) at the Open Music Sessions for the month of June.



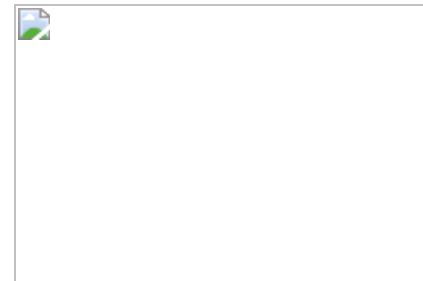
The party starts upstairs with the Countdown Show at 7:30 pm, with free food from [Sexy Pizza](#).

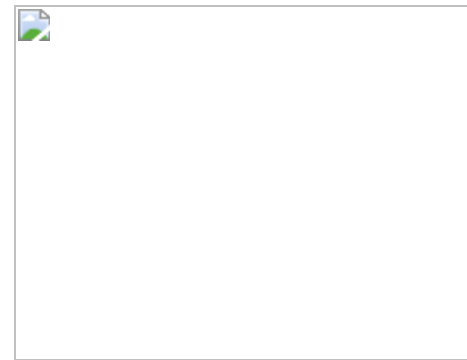
Web Client - Colorado Health Institute

The Video Production Department has just completed a video for client Lutheran Family Services Rocky Mountains. You can watch the video [here](#).

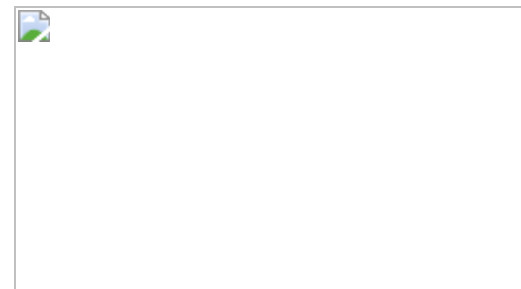

Melissa Kerr and **Kate Mason** are additions to the Web Services team, as Senior UX and Visual Designer and Account Director respectively.

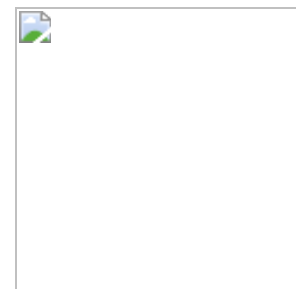
Finally, we have **Dylan Rine** and **Jaina Sorrel** joining the OMF team as [AmeriCorps VISTAs](#).

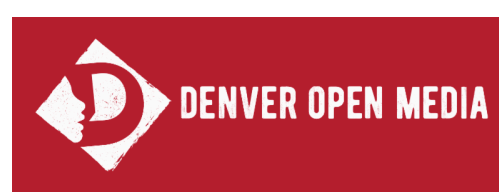
OMF Seeks Drupal Developer

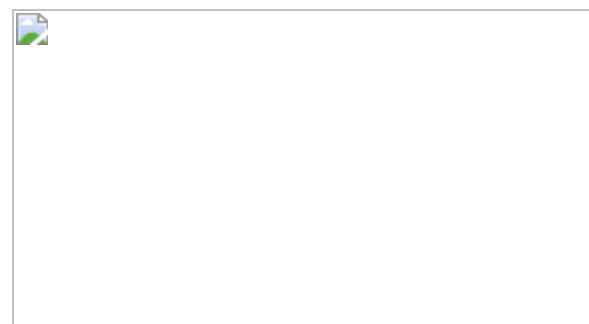

DOM's Top-Rated Show for May

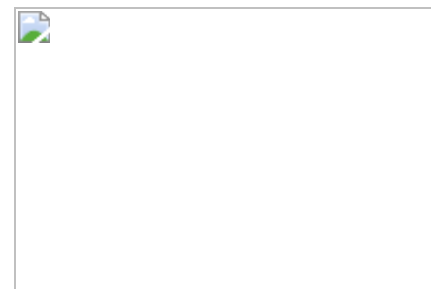

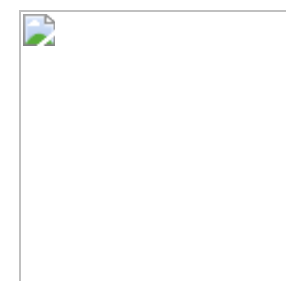
