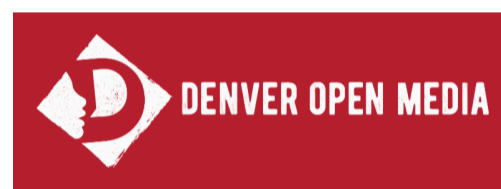

DOM Equipment News

The upgrades to Studio A are complete! We now have five matching [Sony HXC-FB75SC HD ½ chip professional studio cameras](#). The three manually controlled cameras come complete with 20x zoom lens, tallies, viewfinders, rear camera controls including [varizoom zoom controllers](#), and the two robotic cameras come with a new Telemetrics robotic controls. The [RCCP-M](#) features a full color touchscreen interface for easy-to-find camera functions, pan, tilt and zoom speed control knobs. The two robotic cameras are also equipped with teleprompters and clocks controlled by a laptop.
