And it all goes to benefit the work of the Open Media Foundation.

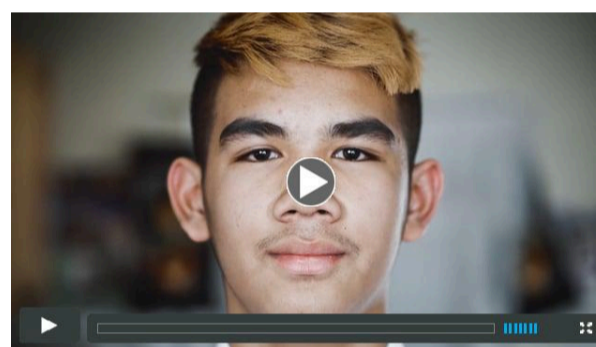
