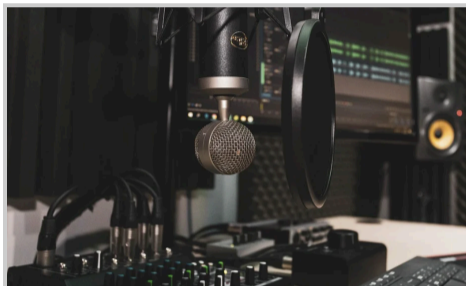
Statewide Internet Portal Authority (SIPA) Annual User Conference

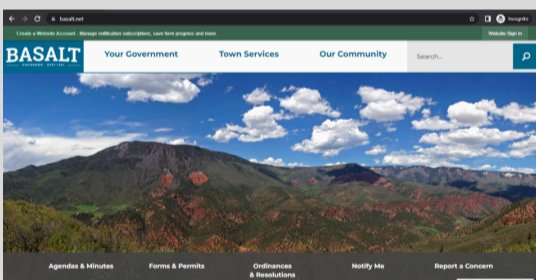
