This travel-friendly device is equipped with dual 15 MP fisheye lenses that enable users to capture hi-res 360-degree videos and 30MP still images. To help with staging, the Gear 360 comes with a mini tripod and can also be used with optional adjustable tripods, such as GorillaPods.
