



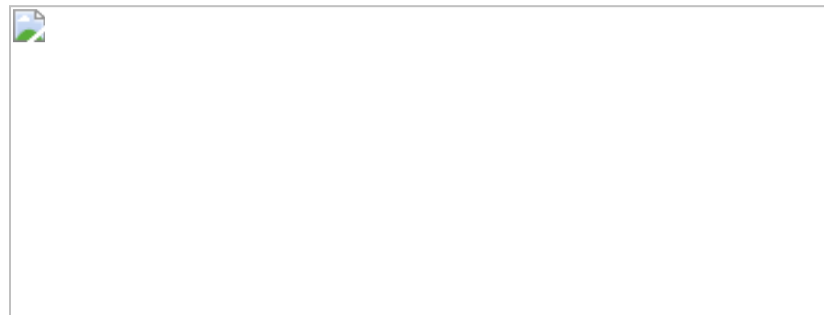

The event starts this Friday, September 7, at 7 pm, at Open Media Foundation (700 Kalamath Street).

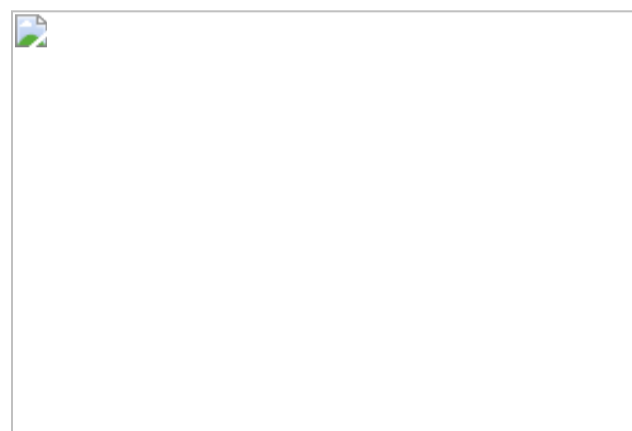

Welcome New AmeriCorps VISTA Joslyn Dorrelle

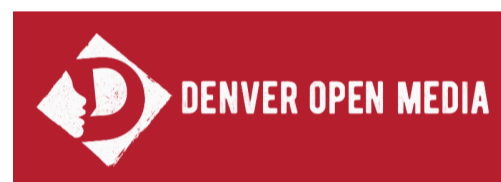
Please join us in welcoming Joslyn Dorrelle to the Open Media Foundation.

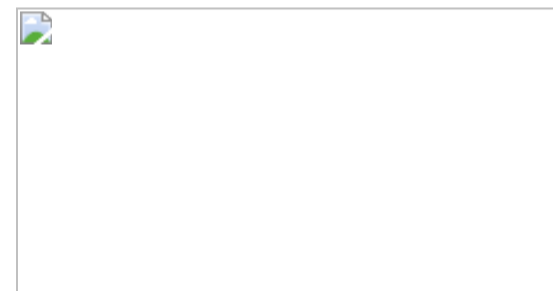

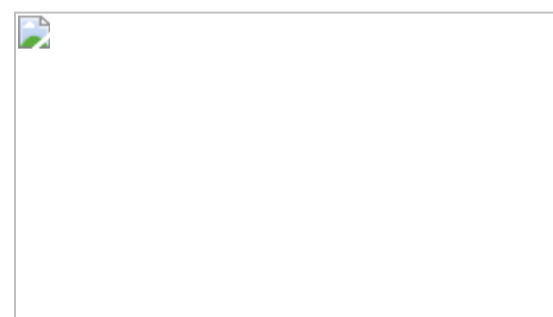
This month the theme block is Youth, and the winner is [Comic Con 2018: Blase](#). The 25 DOM bucks will go to Paulina Núñez!

At Denver Open Media, we have all the accessories you need to get the most power out of your equipment. Here are some of the ones that you will want to use on your next project!



Wireless Transmitter Accessory

Our [Wireless Transmitter Accessory](#) allows you to convert any wired microphone into a wireless microphone - simply plug in the transmitter to the microphone's XLR port, connect to a wireless lavalier receiver, and you're good to go! Only \$5/day for members!

Note: You must reserve a wireless lavalier to be able to use this equipment. Wireless lavaliers are \$15/day for members

Shape Viewfinder for Sony A7S Camera

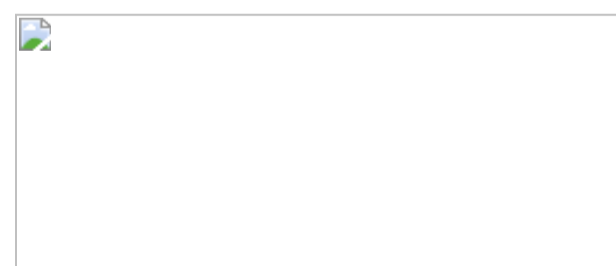

The key to successfully producing a show is gaining support. The clearer and more inviting you can be when describing your show, the more likely you are to connect with those that share your vision.

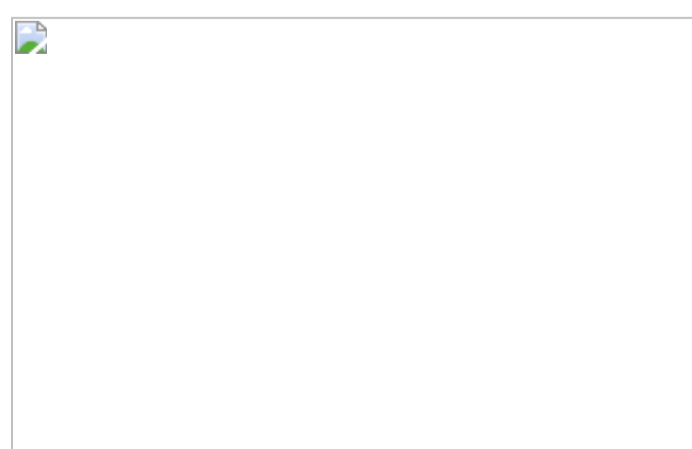
