#### Citizen Observer Projects

Open Media is providing resources and support to organizations dedicated to government transparency. Although local and county governments already make livestreams and recordings of their most important public meetings available, many other monthly public meetings are not. Citizen Observer projects are working together with local governments to fill in resource gaps to make the largest number of meetings available.



**The League of Women Voters of Alabama Education Fund makes Alabama's legislative meetings more accessible to all Alabamians with Open.Media**

The Alabama Channel, a new project of the League of Women Voters of Alabama Education Fund captures and saves live video recordings of all sessions of Alabama's State House and Senate and of legislative committee meetings. The video recordings are now available to the public online and on demand through Open.Media.

**The League of Women Larimer County Colorado Partners with Open.Media and Others to Develop Citizen Observer Project Pilot.**

The pilot developed a template to create new, independent public records of the hundreds of meetings that happen each month in local and county governments. Observers were trained to attend public meetings, then publish the results. Open.Media provided a platform to archive live streams, documentation and transcriptions of the public meetings.

Open.Media is following the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.2 to make our solutions accessible to a wider range of people with disabilities, including accommodations for blindness and low vision, deafness and hearing loss, limited movement, speech disabilities, photosensitivity, and combinations of these, and some accommodation for learning disabilities and cognitive limitations.

#### Integrations Available



**CivicPlus.** The integration imports session information from CivicPlus to create a new live stream session in Open.Media and YouTube.



**OnBase by Hyland Software.** The integration imports information from OnBase to create a live stream session in Open.Media and YouTube. Development was funded by the town of Gilbert, Arizona.



**AgendaQuick by Destiny Software.** The integration imports the AgendaQuick agenda then sends video links and timestamps back to the agenda management application. Development was funded by Goodyear, Arizona.



**PeopleSpeak.** The integration adds the live stream video component to the meeting management application. Constituents can virtually interact in real time with the application's issue-level breakdown of public meetings. Development was funded by Lakewood, Colorado.
